
## **AT UCALGARY**



Results of the April 2023 Survey

**What did we find?** In April 2023 [GSA]<sup>2</sup> sent graduate students a survey to assess the inclusivity of bathrooms at UCalgary. Here are the results:



**Less than half**, or only 43%, of students thought the current bathrooms on campus were at least 'somewhat inclusive'.

## Top four features that would improve inclusivity:



**1.** Floor to ceiling stall walls and doors



2. Hooks in each stall




**3.** Waste receptables in each stall



**4.** Infant change tables in each bathroom

## What washroom options are most comfortable for students?

Respondents indicated that they are most comfortable when there are **both gendered** and **gender neutral options** available. This allows for **everyone** on campus to choose a washroom option that is most comfortable and inclusive.
