

BATHROOM POLICY AT UCALGARY

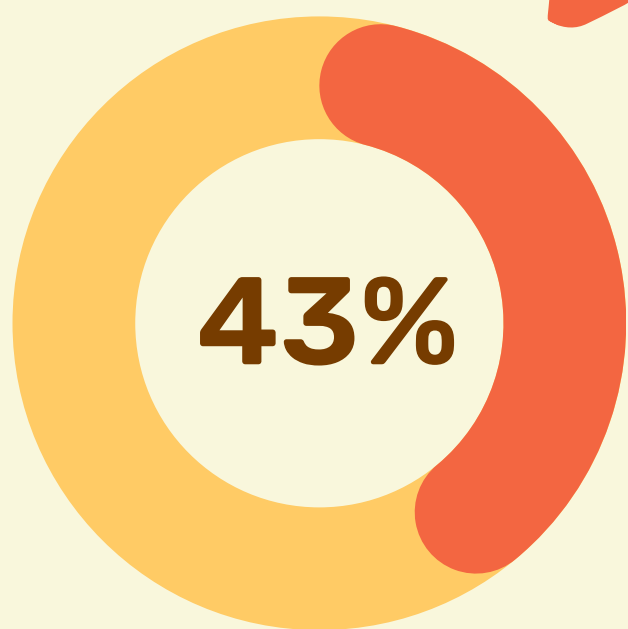
Results of the April 2023 Survey



What did we find? In April 2023 [GSA]^2 sent graduate students a survey to assess the inclusivity of bathrooms at UCalgary. Here are the results:

231

Students responded



Less than half, or only 43%, of students thought the current bathrooms on campus were at least 'somewhat inclusive'.

Top four features that would improve inclusivity:



1. Floor to ceiling stall walls and doors



2. Hooks in each stall



3. Waste receptacles in each stall



4. Infant change tables in each bathroom

What washroom options are most comfortable for students?

Respondents indicated that they are most comfortable when there are **both gendered and gender neutral options** available. This allows for **everyone** on campus to choose a washroom option that is most comfortable and inclusive.



Currently there is a lack of gender neutral bathrooms on the University of Calgary campus
