#### About the Speaker:

Dr. Letourneau is a Professor in the Faculty of Nursing and Cumming School of Medicine (Depts. of Pediatrics, Psychiatry & Community Health Sciences) at the University of Calgary. She is also director of Research and Education for Solutions to Violence (RESOLVE) Alberta and holds a Research Chair in Parent and Child Mental Health. She is Principal Investigator of the Child Health Intervention and Longitudinal Development (CHILD) Studies Program, comprised of multiple projects including the: (1) APrON longitudinal pregnancy cohort of 2200 families funded for follow-up by the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation to 12 years of child age, and (2) the Attachment and Child Health (ATTACH<sup>™</sup>) study funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research to scale and spread this parenting program across Canada. Her research focuses on understanding how parental mental health, violence and adversity affect children's health and creating and testing relevant community-based interventions to promote children's health. She has attained ~\$70 million CAD in research funding, and authored three books, as well as 220+ peer reviewed papers.
