Dr. Neeloffer Mookherjee is an Professor, Department of Internal Medicine and Immunology. As the current CIHR Sex and Gender Science Chair in Circulatory and Respiratory Health, her research program focuses on the impact of sex as a biological variable on respiratory disease progression and response to therapy. Her research also integrates aspects of how environmental exposures such as air pollution impact chronic disease. She is actively integrating fundamentals of Sex and Gender Based Analyses in all aspects of her research program. Dr. Mookherjee is a strong advocate for women in science, and is the current Chair of the WISDOM (Women in Science; Development, Outreach and Mentorship) initiative at The Rady Faculty of Health Science.
