









■ Total Emergency Room Visits by CTAS Score Admissions from ACH Emergency Room by CTAS Score





Researchers in the Department of Pediatrics have faced unprecedented challenges in the past few years when the pandemic brought clinical research at all sites - including the Alberta Children's Hospital - to a halt.
