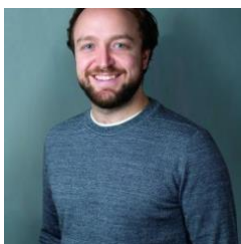
Management of urinary tract infections in hospitalized patients under 3 months of age: What you need to know as a Hospital Pediatrician
