3-year undergraduate medical school Years 1 and 2 are pre-clerkship and have a new curriculum called RIME (Re-Imagining Medical Education)

RIME focuses on 4 pedagogical principles

- Spirality
- Generalism
- Patient Centered
- Integration

UME Year 2

Primarily clerkship and students rotate through ACH under CTU and subspecialties, the emergency department at ACH and SHC, the neonatal nurseries, community pediatricians' offices
