Preceptors commit to 2 sessions of 2-hour clinical bedside teaching with a small group of medical students. Students will contact the preceptor directly to organize the sessions. Sessions may be held in the community offices, outpatient clinics, or on the ward. Preceptors are asked to recruit their own patients for these sessions.
