Study on Pediatric Patient-reported Outcome Measures

The Person-Centred Care Team (PI: Dr. Maria Santana) from the University of Calgary is conducting a second mixed methods study to better understand the uptake of pediatric patient-reported outcome measures (PROMs) and patient-reported experience measures (PREMs) in Alberta.

The primary aim of this study is to understand how PROMs and PREMs are being utilized in Alberta's pediatric healthcare settings, whether in clinical care or in research. We are interested in the perspectives of healthcare professionals, administrators and researchers in Alberta who work in pediatric settings, irrespective of their experience using PROMs and PREMs. This will allow us to generate an accurate snapshot of what, where, and how these measures are being implemented. This research will be instrumental in constructing a provincial implementation strategy for these patient-centered instruments.
