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What are your current education roles/positions?

Chair of the RCPSC AFC subcommittee in Pediatric and Perinatal Pathology. In addition, I work with pathology residents during their specialty rotation at ACH, and clinical fellowship programs. I am the lead preceptor for the oncological pathology rotation of the pediatric hemato-oncology fellowship program and give monthly histopathology lectures during the academic half days of the pediatric GI fellowship program.

What do you enjoy most about working in Medical Education?

Being a part of the educational journey of current and future clinical colleagues, challenges me to stay up to date, reflect on and adjust my teaching style, and makes me appreciate how important active learning and repetition are. Teaching is a team effort and learners greatly contribute to its success. Pathology is often perceived as daunting and pathologists as invisible. It is rewarding that my passion for pediatric pathology and teaching helps break down these barriers and translates into a positive learning experience for learners and staff; to experience that they no longer dread case discussions with pathologists or pathology questions at their exams. I am grateful to all the learners, clinical and pathology colleagues, patients, and families I have had the privilege to work with throughout my career. By sharing their experience and expertise with me, they fuelled my passion for pediatric pathology, allowed me to learn and appreciate how my work informs and impacts their care, and expanded my professional horizon beyond the oculars of my microscope.





Department member Dr. Gregory Guilcher is a Co-I on a Genome Canada award "Longitudinal, Deep-Phenotyped Pediatric Databank of Medical and Drug Therapy Outcomes". Department members Drs. Michele Ramien and Gesche Riabowol are also a part of this.







This funding will continue to support a national network that helps identify which children are at risk for adverse drug reactions and apply these predictive models in clinical practice.
