The All Our Families (AOF) Study at the University of Calgary has data available for access! The AOF study is a Calgary based, longitudinal cohort study launched in 2008 with over 3000 pregnant women recruited, and we have been regularly following these participants and their children through time.



The study data collected contains a wealth of information, including pregnancy, breastfeeding, health service utilization, maternal and child mental health, physical activity, school life, employment, community connections, family relationships, participant experiences through the COVID-19 pandemic, and so much more. 


