What are the current Education roles/positions that you hold?

In addition to my clinical teaching, I am currently one of the assistant program directors (academic support) for general pediatrics and a RIME small group facilitator in UME. I also teach a graduate course, Curriculum Oversight and Stewardship (MDPR 631) which is part of the Cumming School of Medicine Precision Program.

What do you enjoy most about working in Medical Education, and what tips would you like to share?

It is hard to pick one thing! I really enjoy teaching clinical skills, and I have been a small group preceptor for medical student communication and physical exam sessions throughout my career, regardless of my other roles and responsibilities. However, I also enjoy "behind the scenes" projects in curriculum development, trainee support and examination development.

Perhaps the most rewarding experience for me is to watch students succeed and move on to be residents and then colleagues! Although I am only a small part of each individual journey, it is very special to help along the way by supporting their learning or personal needs.

I encourage residents to give me feedback if they are observing me with a patient or family. This allows them to more actively notice communication strategies and reflect on the process of the interaction. It also models both giving and receiving feedback.




Announcement from AHS Zone Medical Director: Facility Medical Director – Alberta Children's Hospital Dr. David Chaulk


