CARE Award - Clinician

Hemoglobinopathy Clinic

This new award celebrates innovative contributions by multidisciplinary teams, with at least one member affiliated with the Department.

We are proud to recognize the Hemoglobinopathy Clinic for its exemplary collaborative approach and impactful innovation. Originally launched as a quality improvement initiative, the clinic addressed a critical gap in patient care—low participation in pulmonary function testing (PFTs). By integrating testing and clinical

assessments into the Hematology visit, the team significantly improved patient engagement and outcomes. Their efforts were previously recognized with an AHS President's Award in 2017, underscoring the clinic's sustained excellence and commitment to patient-centered care.

We also extend our sincere appreciation to Dr. Kim Myers for her outstanding work on the "Highlighting the Best of Your Section" project. Her insightful reports played a key role in identifying and celebrating deserving individuals and teams like the Hemoglobinopathy Clinic, whose contributions might have otherwise gone unrecognized.



In this interactive hands-on workshop you will learn:


- The importance of QI data


