Fall 2025/2026 CSM Grant Development RISE Program: Call for Applications

The CSM Grant Development Office's RISE Program is now open to CSM researchers at all career stages. The CSM Grant Development Research funding Immersive Support and Education (RISE) Program is designed to guide independent researchers who have limited grant writing experience through the process of developing a competitive grant application.

What are the benefits for participants?

RISE participants will

- hone their grant-writing skills;
- establish effective grant development practices; and
- expand their research funding knowledge.
- With the guidance of experienced faculty members and internal peer reviewers and support from the CSM Grant Development Office, participants will work throughout the 12-month program to develop a CIHR Project Grant application

Upon completing the program, participants will be poised to

- submit their applications to the Fall 2026 CIHR Project Grant competition;
- further develop their applications for a future Project Grant competition; and/or
- apply their learnings to other funding opportunities

While the RISE program uses the CIHR Project Grant as a model, the skills and knowledge participants develop during the program will be relevant to a variety of funding opportunities.

RISE program participants who meet the participant responsibilities outlined below will be eligible to apply for RISE seed funding (valued at \$25,000 for one year).




Thank You from the Sibling Superhero Day Committee

The ACH is currently in the process of installing a new Nurse Call system throughout the entire hospital. For the new nurse call system to be validated, each room that has a Code Blue button must be tested individually to ensure that it works. We recognize that this can be disruptive to teams each day but are also restricted to daytime hours to protect patient rest times.

Due to continued high capacity at the site, it has been challenging to get into some inpatient rooms. While originally the project was slated to finish at the end of July, it is now projected to finish by late-August to mid-September.
