

Responding to Secondary Traumatic Stress in Medical Education | Two Day, Inperson Workshop for Physicians in Practice

The importance of trauma-informed medical education has been recognized, although there has been less attention to the potential risks of secondary traumatic stress and vicarious trauma among preceptors involved in supporting residents.

To address this gap, this interactive workshop for physicians in practice introduces participants to Resilience for Trauma-Informed Professionals, an evidence-informed curriculum that has been developed to help preceptors develop skills to reduce the risk of secondary traumatic stress (STS) as they work with learners who have experienced trauma and encounter trauma in their work. The workshop will offer individual as well as organizational approaches for preventing, monitoring, and responding to STS and strategies that can help foster a STS-resilient workplace.

This two day, in-person workshop will be held at the Foothills Campus - the small registration fee includes lunch on Day 1. Please note, that participants *must* attend both days.




