## **ED Team Instructions**

Saline Fluid in Sepsis
Complete study Eligibility Form in full:  Sign, date, and time the form as soon as randomization occurs  Place completed form back in the sepsis cart in the drawer labelled "Completed Forms"
Identify Fluid Allocation:  Fluid outlined in this package is the fluid to be administered (colour coded)  0.9% Normal Saline (NS - green)  Balanced Fluids (BF - pink) - Lactated Ringers
<ul> <li>Place order in IV Fluids in EPIC under Sepsis Order Set- IV Fluids- PRoMPT Study – For <u>ALL boluses and maintenance fluid</u> provided in the ED:         <ul> <li>Order the fluid type (NS or BF) specified by the randomization information</li> <li><u>Note:</u> Hypotonic fluids (i.e. 0.45NS) are not considered appropriate for bolus or maintenance fluids in septic children and should be avoided</li> <li>When and how much fluid should be decided based on clinical need by the clinical care team.</li> <li>Obtain fluids from Study Cart or from clinical ED inventory</li> <li>Additives (e.g. Dextrose, KCI) can be used as needed</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Open large envelope that corresponds with the randomization. (Green = NS. Pink = BF)
Write date and time of fluid start on IV hang tag where indicated and hang the tag on pole
Place the patient bracelet on the patient wrist
Provide Caregiver with the Caregiver Information Sheet. <a href="If-family requests information">If-family requests information</a> :  This study is approved to be conducted under a deferred consent model  The patient/caregiver will not consent before randomization/fluid administration occur  A member of the study team will approach the family when it is clinically appropriate
Verbally inform the admitting team that the child is participating in the PRoMPT BOLUS Study <ul> <li>Inpatient/PICU teams should continue to order allocated study fluid TYPE (NS or BF)</li> <li>through 23:59 on the calendar day following randomization.</li> </ul>
If patient is discharged from ED – discontinue fluids at discharge
If patient meets Stopping Criteria, manage the child at your discretion
