## Inpatient/PICU Team Instructions

BC Children's Hospital (BCCH)



- □ Receive patient. Inpatient Instructions will be in patient's physical chartlet.
- □ Identify Fluid Allocation:
  - Documents and treatment assignment are colour coded
    - Yellow Normal Saline
    - Green Balanced Fluids (Lactated Ringers or PlasmaLyte)
- □ The Caregiver has received a Caregiver Study Information Sheet
  - This study is approved to be conducted under a **deferred consent** model
  - The patient/caregiver will not consent before randomization/fluid administration occurs.
  - A member of the study team will approach the family when it is clinically appropriate:
    - May occur after all fluids have been administered
    - This will be a member of the ED Research Team
- □ Order fluids in CST for <u>ALL boluses and maintenance fluid required through 23:59 on the</u> <u>calendar day following randomization</u>:
  - Please order the fluid TYPE specified by randomization (normal saline or balanced fluids)
  - <u>Note:</u> Hypotonic fluids (i.e. 0.45NS) are not considered appropriate for bolus or maintenance fluids in septic children and should be avoided.
  - When and how much fluid should be decided based on clinical need by the clinical care team.
  - Obtain fluids from clinical inventory.
  - Document ALL IV and IO fluid given to the patient during this time.
  - Similarly for maintenance fluids, please use D5 Normal or D5 Ringers as per their randomization.
- □ Keep any study forms that have moved with the patient with the medical chart:
  - Hang IV Hang Tag with fluid start and stop date from ED on patient's IV
