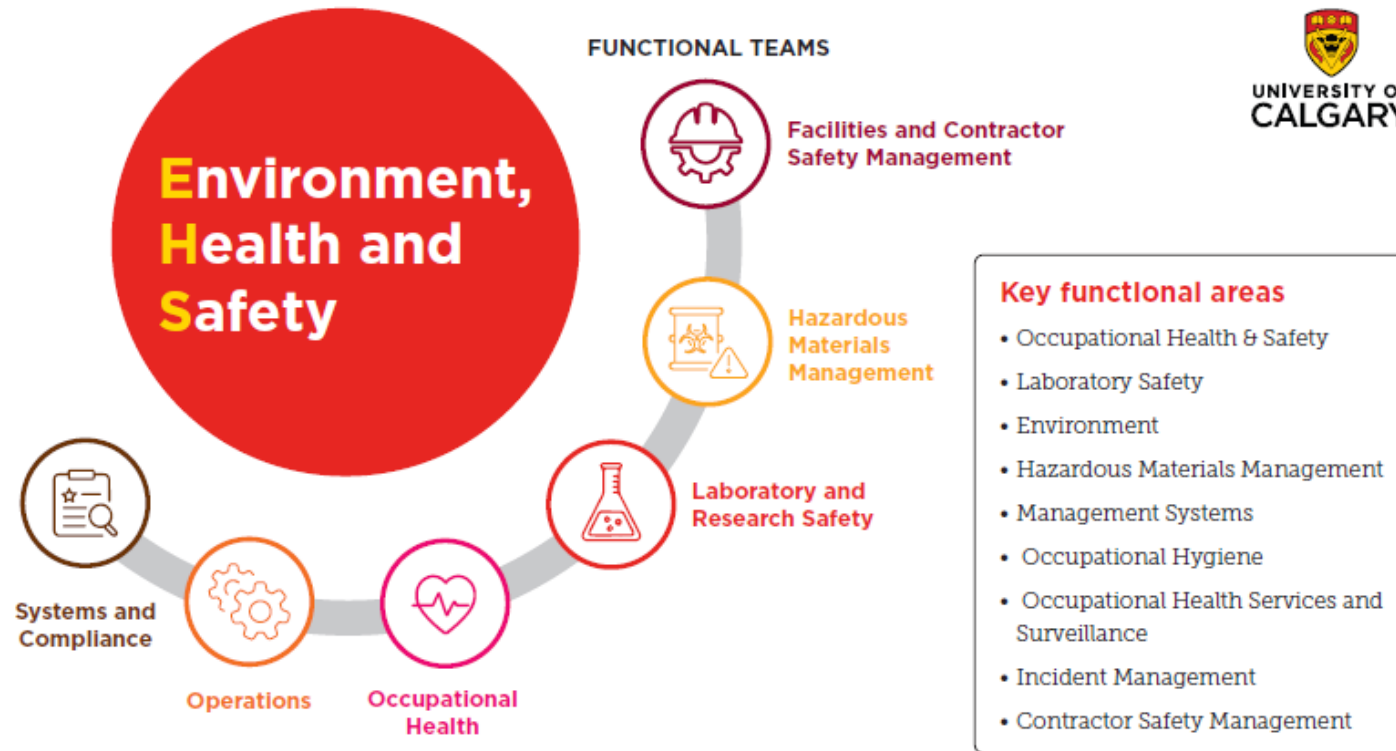


Environment, Health and Safety

Develop and advance hazard identification and risk reduction programs

with the goal of increasing awareness and eliminating incidents that result in loss.



Develop and enhance contractor management programs

to ensure appropriate due diligence measures are completed and correct oversight is maintained to effectively reduce risk and liability for UCalgary.



Evaluate service delivery requirements

across our team with the goal of improving service quality and efficiency.



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
