
LIBREVIEW INFO SHEET AND AGREEMENT

FOR AHS ADULT DIABETES CENTRE CALGARY PATIENTS

Libre is a company registered in the US that allows a person to create an account to upload data from their Libre flash glucose monitor to their web-based server. The purpose is to help you and your healthcare providers better manage your diabetes.

The Libre website is at <https://www2.libreview.com/>

The Libre monitor collects glucose values which are transmitted to their web based server for your own personal use.

AGREEMENT TO SHARE INFORMATION WITH DIABETES CENTRE CALGARY

If you decide to share your information with the AHS Diabetes Centre Calgary (DCC), only staff authorized to provide you with health services will be able to view your information. This will occur only for the purpose of providing you with health services. Please note that **your data is looked at by clinic staff ONLY when they are actively providing services to you, and is not monitored regularly.**

Your sharing of data uploaded to LibreView is voluntary and will not impact the health services you receive at DCC.

If you choose to share your information and change your mind later, you may revoke your sharing agreement at any time.

If you agree to share your data with AHS staff at DCC (Diabetes Centre Calgary), please input the following on

To add the DCC clinic via the smart phone App:

In the App, Go to: Menu > Connected Apps > LibreView Manage > Connect to a Practice > Enter Practice ID (e3c5493rojj4rjhe) > Next > Connect

To add the DCC clinic via the website:

1. Open your Libre account on a computer (at <https://www2.libreview.com/>). **Be sure to use the same username and password** as you used for your phone App, so that it's the data from your phone App that is shared with the clinic.
2. Go to Settings > My Practices > Link to a Practice.
3. Enter the Practice ID (e3c5493rojj4rjhe). Click 'Add'.
