





Researching

Congratulations to Dr. Erin Brennand, her MSc thesis was published to the Green Journal: <u>Evaluation of the Effect of Surgeons Operative</u>. As well on her cross appointment to Community Health Sciences and Supervisory privileges within Graduate Studies.



Many of the research that was being done in the department has been stalled due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Reduce Trial: Data collection complete, chart review and data entry on going

MUST (Mid-Urethral Sling Tension) trial: Presented at the 2019 International Urogynecology Association & American Urogynecologic Society joint meeting. Has also been accepted to the Green Journal for publication.

HUPPS (Hysterectomy or Uterine Preservation for Prolapse Study): In the process of starting up. Received an MSI Foundation grant of \$100,000. Recruitment to start soon.

Dr. Kim-Fine and Dr. Brennand continue to be active in the Collaborative Research in Pelvic Surgery Consortium (CoRPS), being actively involved in their FPMRS Challenges publication series.
