### What is the ACP/GCD Tracking Record?

- The ACP/GCD Tracking Records are AHS forms that healthcare providers use to document conversations that have taken place regarding a patient's Advance Care Plan and Goals of Care Designation (GCD) or related topics.
- The forms reflect what was talked about, who was involved, what was decided and the reasons for the decisions, from the oldest to most recent conversations.

#### Advance Care Planning/Goals of Care Designation Tracking Record


Purpose: to document the content of Advance Care Planning (ACP)/Goals of Care Designation (GCD) conversations and/or decisions.

#### Benefits:

- Assists healthcare providers in being aware of previous conversations and to understand the reasons underlying the current GCD order.
- Gives clues about where to pick up the conversation if decisions need to be reviewed or confirmed.

# Who should be documenting on the ACP/GCD Tracking Record?

- The Tracking Record is for any health care professional or member of the healthcare team to use to document key elements of any Advance Care Planning, Goals of Care, or related conversations (such as, Serious Illness Conversations) they have had with a patient or their alternate decision maker.
- Patients and families don't write on this form.



### Why Using The Tracking Record Is Important

Documenting Advance Care planning, Goals of Care, and related conversations on the Tracking Record is important because the Tracking Record is *provided to the patient* upon discharge/transfer (in a Green Sleeve with their GCD order). In Connect Care, Tracking Records are labeled as such for easy filtering.

If these conversations are documented elsewhere in the patient chart (for example, buried in consult or progress note), other healthcare providers may not readily access them.


### Benefits of using the Tracking Record

- Helps the next healthcare provider understand the reasons for the current GCD and Goals of Care decisions.
- Gives clues about where to pick up the conversation if decisions need to be made, reviewed or confirmed.
- Saves people from having to tell their story over and over.
- Allows for correct and consistent interpretation of the current GCD order.
- Shows that these conversations occurred with the patient.

### What Do I Do with the Tracking Record?

- The Tracking Record is the property of the patient.
- After you document on the Tracking Record, it should be reviewed with the patient for accuracy and to ensure consistency with any Goals of Care decisions.
- The tracking Record needs to be printed out and provided to the patient in a Green Sleeve (with their current GCD order) upon discharge/transfer.


### The Green Sleeve: A Patient's "Health Passport" (Paper Version Document images)


# Accessing the ACP/GCD Tracking Record In Connect Care:

Option 1 – via the ACP/GCD Navigator


# Access ACPGCD Tracking Record via the **ACP/GCD Navigator**:

- Click the GCD hyperlink in patient storyboard to open the ACP/GCD Navigator.
- From the ACP/GCD navigator you can access the Tracking Record, view previous entries, and create a new note from the menu on the Left or by scrolling the main window down. See next slide for images.



### Printing the Tracking Record from Connect Care


- Printing the Tracking Record from the ACP/GCD Navigator is not currently an option.
- Printing the Tracking Record needs to be done via the 'Chart Review Notes tab'

#### Printing ACP/GCD Tracking Record

- In Chart Review, select Notes.
- 2. Find and Select the Tracking Note you would like to print. When you select the tracking note, a preview window will open on the right hand side.
- 3. Click the print symbol.
- 4. A print window will open allowing you to select the printer of your choice.



# Accessing the Tracking Record In Connect Care: Option 2 – via "Chart Review Notes Tab"

In addition to printing the Tracking Record via the Chart Review Notes tab (see previous slide), you can also access the Tracking Record to document a new entry and to review previous entries this way.

- In Chart Review, select Notes
- Sort or Filter by Note Type
  - Select Tracking Record



## Viewing Tracking Record Entries In Connect Care via the "Chart Review Notes Tab"

#### View All ACP Related Notes Entries

- In ACP/GCD navigator, select Tracking Record.
- 2. Tracking Record Notes will display
- 3. Click **See All Notes** to go to the notes activity.
- 4. Select Tracking Record tab. This is where you can see all notes of this type that have been filed during the inpatient admission





All ACP Tracking Record notes are also visible in Chart Review Notes tab. Sort or filter by Note Type

# Documenting on the Tracking Record In Connect Care via the "Chart Review Notes Tab" Add a new note (Inpateint)

#### Add a New Tracking Record Note with Notes activity (Inpatient)

- 1. In the Notes Activity Section click New Note.
- 2. In Type: Tracking Record ✓ Accept
- 3. Choose Service Area if requested
- 4. Complete narrative Smart tools are allowed.
- 5. Once you sign the note, the note will show in Notes Activity under Tracking Record.

# Printing the Tracking Record from Connect Care using the Chart Review Notes Tab


 This is currently the only way to print Tracking Records from Connect Care

#### Printing ACP/GCD Tracking Record

- 1. In Chart Review, select Notes.
- 2. Find and Select the Tracking Note you would like to print. When you select the tracking note, a preview window will open on the right hand side.
- Click the print symbol.
- 4. A print window will open allowing you to select the printer of your choice.
