

Department of Medicine Residency Conference Travel Fund

Purpose: To help support residents within the department to present their research at National and International conferences and research meetings

Summary

- Limited amount of funding available, will be reviewed on annual basis
- Rolling applications accepted until annual funds are spent
- Applied towards travel, accommodation and registration fees
- Maximum of \$2000 per award
- Maximum one award per resident while in a training program (i.e. one during core IM training; one during subspecialty training)
 - DOM will fund core IM residents
 - Division will fund subspecialty residents within their programs

Application Criteria

- Full time core IM resident or subspecialty resident within the Department of Medicine and in good standing
- Application prior to (or within 1 year of) conference occurring
- Travel while completing residency at the University of Calgary
- Research conducted at the University of Calgary
- Resident is presenting author
- Abstract accepted for an oral presentation (Poster presentations will be considered for funding if key International meeting in the field of research)
- National or International meeting (not a research day, retreat, virtual meeting)
- Original research (case reports not eligible)

Documents required

- Completed application form
- Confirmation of acceptance for oral presentation
- Copy of abstract
- Statement outlining contribution to research
