Symptoms:

- Upper and Lower GI Bleeding,
- Abdominal Pain
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea,
- Dysphagia
- Constipation
- Weight loss
- Jaundice
- Ascites

Conditions:

- Peptic Ulcer Disease
- Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- Irritable Bowel Syndrome
- Colorectal Cancer
- Viral Hepatitis
- Abnormal Liver Tests
